## Routes to the Show Site

From Houston, take Hwy 59 Business exit. Go approximately 7 miles to Ben Wilson. Turn left and go approximately 1½ miles to North Street. Turn right on North Street. The Community Center will be directly on your left.

From San Antonio – turn left on Loop 463. Follow it approximately 5 miles to Hwy 59. Turn right. Go approximately 2 miles to Ben Wilson. Turn left to North Street. Turn Right on North Street. The Community Center is on your left.

From Corpus Christi – follow Hwy 59 Business into town. Turn right on Ben Wilson, then right on North Street. The Community Center is on your left.

Owners or owner's agent is responsible for errors on entry forms. Entry fee(s) WILL NOT be refunded in the event of such error, cancellations received after the closing date, or in the event that a dog is absent, disqualified, excused by a Veterinarian or Judge, or barred from competition by the Show Committee.

Entry fee(s) will not be refunded in the event that the dog is absent, disqualified, excused, or barred from competition by action of the Trial Committee. No entry fee(s) will be returned if the Trial cannot open or be completed by reason of civil disturbance, fire, flood, public emergency, act of a public enemy, act of God, or any other cause beyond the control of the organizing committee.

Move-ups in Rally and Obedience will be allowed as specified in Chapter 1, Section 16 of the Obedience Regulations. ***The request for a move-up must be in writing and presented to the superintendent or trial secretary at least 30 minutes prior to the start of Saturday's trial. Move-ups for Sunday must be given to the show secretary on Saturday prior to the close of Saturday's show.***

AS SPACE IS LIMITED NO X-PENS WILL BE ALLOWED INSIDE THE BUILDING AND CRATES MUST BE STACKED. Due to limited crating space, unentered dogs are NOT allowed on the show grounds. All dogs must be at least six months of age on the day of the trial.

No dogs will be allowed through the front doors of the Community Center. Exhibitors with dogs must enter and leave the building through the side doors. No dogs are allowed on the grass or landscaped area at the front of the building.

The building will be available on Saturday morning at 8:00AM and Sunday morning at 7:00AM. There will be no early setup on Friday evening.

Bitches in season will not be permitted within the trial premises. Entry fees WILL NOT be refunded in the event a bitch entered in the trial comes into season.

If an entry is sent by any express mail carrier, please check the NO SIGNATURE REQUIRED box.

Checks that have been returned due to insufficient funds do not constitute a valid entry and will have a \$25.00 service charge attached.

Changes, additions or corrections to entry forms must be received in writing prior to close of entries. Those received by telephone are not acceptable.

IMPORTANT: Please include a \$2.00 processing fee per entry. If you do not have a PayPal account, it is easy to set one up. Just click on "Sign Up" and follow the directions. There are no sign-up fees.

The AKC has charged Trial giving clubs the responsibility to enforce the Rules and Regulations forbidding drilling and/or unacceptable training on the trial grounds. Chapter 2, section 28 - The use of spiked or other special training collars WILL NOT be permitted on the trial site. DRILLING, INTENSIVE OR ABUSIVE TRAINING ON THE SHOW GROUNDS WILL NOT BE TOLERATED. These requirements should not be interpreted as preventing a handler from moving normally about the grounds or premises or from moving normally about the grounds or premises or from warming up their dog using any exercise performed in the obedience ring, provided the dog is on a leash being held by the handler. Warm-ups should be performed as far from the obedience rings as is reasonably possible and must not be disruptive to any dog or person. Physical or verbal disciplining of a dog will not be permitted, except to a reasonable extent in case of an attack on either a dog or a person.

Trophies and other prizes will be awarded in the judging ring. NO awards will be mailed. ALL unclaimed awards will become the property of the show-giving club.

A show photographer will be available both days.
